## MOLSON COORS – Stó:lō Culture Heritage COMMEMORATION Molson Coors Fraser Valley Brewery at Chilliwack

Molson Coors is putting forth a tender for applications to design and install a commemorative piece of artwork for the lobby of their new brewing facility in Chilliwack, British Columbia.

This piece of art will be designed and completed by a member of the Stó:lō to commemorate the heritage of the Stó:lō in the area and lands on which the Molson Coors brewery is located at Vedder Road and the trans-Canada highway.

***The artwork or piece created shall be no larger than 2 metres by 2 metres or 6 feet by 6 feet, in order to be placed in the public entry way to the brewing facility.***

The artwork or piece created will also be accompanied by a plaque that will describe the artwork, and its relevance to the story of the Stó:lō in these parts of S'ólh Téméxw. The project in its completed state will not exceed a budgeted amount of \$5,000.00 including materials, labour, installation and commemorative plaque.
